# Show types

- Live or Live-to-Tape studio show
- Narrative Productions
- One-time Productions (concerts, telethons, variety show, documentary etc)

# Live or Live-to-tape

- 30 minutes
- Studio show
- Example: News, Breaking Sound, Wired Up, Titan Overtime, Overnight with Oscar

# Narratives

- Episodic shows also including sitcoms
- 4 Episodes
- Max 30 minutes
  
- Example: Touch of Reality, Curtain Call, The Professionals, Hello Campers!

# One time productions

- Studio or field production
- Varies in length
- Example: History of Oshkosh, Wisco, Live from AC West, Cole and Claudia's Christmas Special, Plot Twist

# What You Need To Do

- Studio Shows: Explain what a typical show will entail. Include talent needs, recurring segments, interview examples, etc.
- Narrative Show: Explain the basic plot for your show. Include detailed episode descriptions of the 4 episodes and character descriptions of your main cast.
- Special Productions: Explain your one-hour special. Include detailed information related to production needs, locations and partnerships that may be required.

# Think About Producers

- **Executive Producer** - Usually the show's creator, the executive producer is the individual primarily responsible for executing the creation of a show overseeing the show's budget, staff, and schedule. The EP is the primary liaison between the production and the Titan TV executive staff.
- **Producer** - General producers will work underneath the executive producer in various areas of the production. Depending on the style and demands of a production, producers may be responsible for: show segments, promotions, equipment, camera department, post-production, etc.
- Every producer should fill out a producer application and send one in- Even if you are not tied to a certain show
